

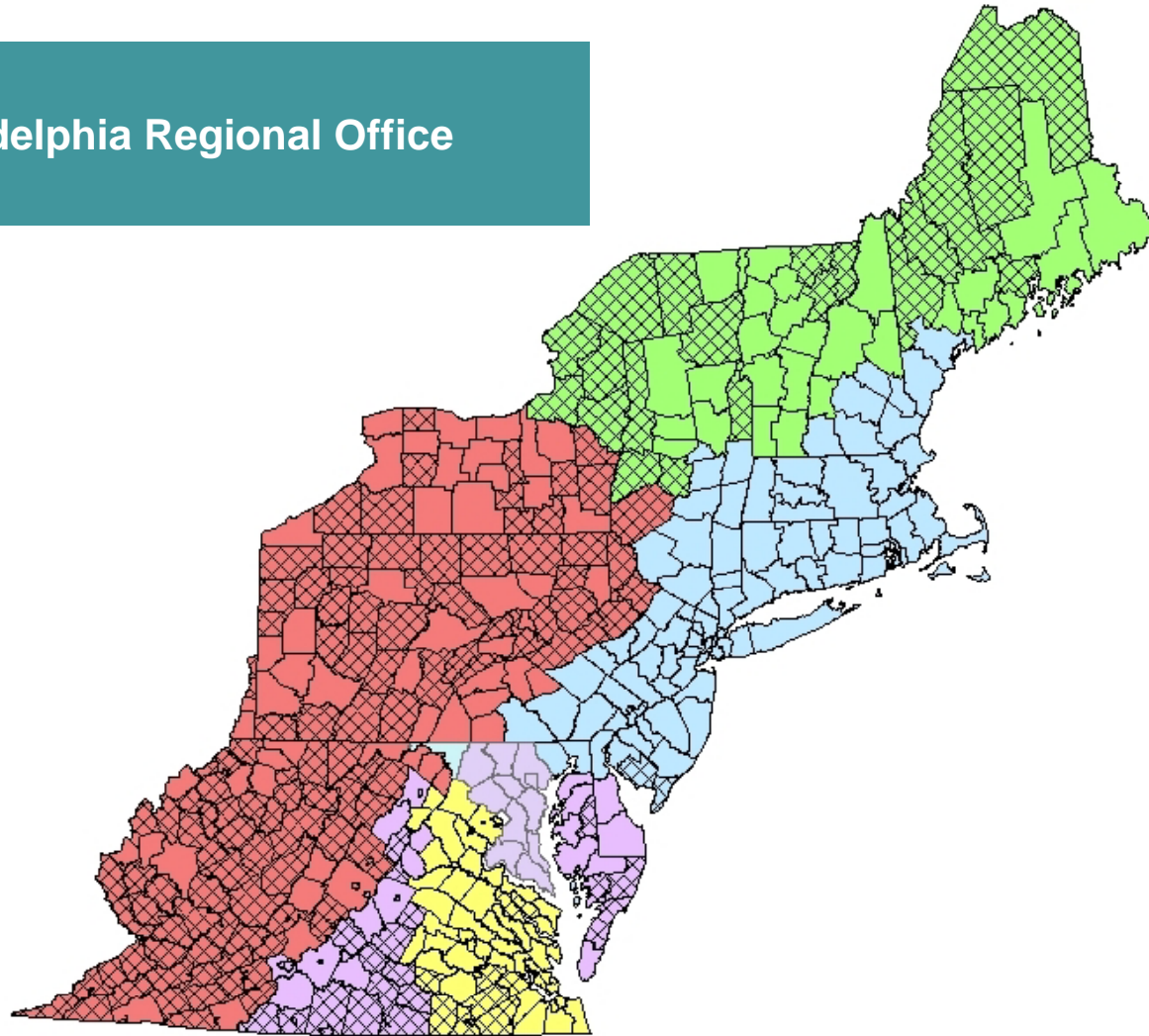

PRO: Energy Task Force

Recommendations:

- Develop Virtual Resource Site
 - www.dsire.org supported by DOE
- Identify New Green Infrastructure
- Identify and Coordinate the Development of Demonstration Projects across PRO: PR, Maine, and WV examples
- **Award Excellence in Energy Awards:** Excellence in Environmental or Energy Economic Development that requires the entry to promote innovative strategies in the development of environmental or energy led projects that attract substantial private capital investment and create higher skill and higher wage jobs.
- Work with EPA, DOL, and DOE to create memoranda of agreements to work collaboratively

GCCMIF PROGRAM*

Global Climate Change Mitigation Investment Fund

- **Renewable Energy:** Development, production, or use of energy derived from sources that do not deplete finite natural resources, including wind, solar, biomass, and geothermal.
- **Energy Efficiency:** Reduction in the energy produced or the energy consumed for the same level of output with the goal of lowering energy costs.
- **Reuse/Recycling/Restoration:** Reuse of a given product(s), or production of a new or innovative product from recyclable materials. Might include waste management practices that reduce raw material usage and the amount of waste that ends up in landfills. This category includes ecosystem restoration.
- **Green Building:** New construction or renovation that is certified by LEED or other comparable certification program.

Review Process

- Regional Planning and Development Councils
 - 3 cover 9 MD counties + Baltimore City Planning Office
 - 11 cover WV's 55 counties
- Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)
- Eligibility: Demographics, government, education, and non-profits
- Private Job Creation
- Private Investment Attraction
- Secure Local Cash Match

Process

- Discuss idea with Regional District
- Review of CEDS
- Project and Document Private Job Creation
- Project and Document Private Investment
- Identify and Secure Local Cash Match
- If construction:
 - Legal Title to Property
 - SHPO and US F/WL
