2019-2020 Highlights

2019

- Work with Congress on program continuation (<u>from zero to full restore</u>)
- Focus on development of NASA re-Authorization language (85/10/5) L/D
- Funding increase to \$44M with 5% admin
- Base funding restored to \$760K
- Multi-year (4-year awards)
- Excellent communications with NASA OSTEM

2020

- Broad support for Space Grant from Congress (program growth)
- Focus on development of NASA re-Authorization language (85/10/5) L/D
- Dear Colleague Letter (Wexton/Peters) 107 signatures (bipartisan)
- Funding increase to \$48M with 5% admin
- Base funding increased to \$770K
- Special Programs (Artemis), \$1.2M/year (\$0.6M SG + \$0.6M MD)
- Excellent communications with NASA HQ
- House appropriations for 2021 recommends \$50M with 5% language





Budget Discussion (2019)

Space Grant Allocation \$44.0M

Expenses:

	Description
\$35.5 M	Base Funding (Alliance Survey) – Average: \$683K/state
\$5.4 M	OSTEM Management Fee (estimate)
\$1.5 M	NIFS Program - (SG Foundation)
\$1.6 M	Other - (\$1M USIP Launches, \$1M Big Idea Challenge)

Note: If all states requested \$760K, then total base funding is \$39.5M





Budget Discussion (2020)

Space Grant Allocation \$48.0M*

Expenses:

	Description
\$38.1 M	Base Funding (Alliance Survey) – Average: \$727K/state
\$5.4 M	OSTEM Management Fee (estimate)
\$1.0 M	Program Evaluation (year 1)
\$ 0.6 M	Artemis Student Challenge (\$1.2M/year for 2 years)
\$2.9 M	Other - (Big Idea Challenge, special projects)

- Note: (1) Allocation may be less since first 3 months were under a \$44M CR.
 - (2) If all states requested \$760K, then base funding is \$39.8M

Note: SG grew by \$4M in 2020 but we are receiving only \$10K increase in base funding.
