2004 NASA Appropriations Bill Language

The Conference Bill passed on Dec 8th, 2003 by the House, and later by the Senate and then signed into law, contains the following language:

## **EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

The Committee has included \$25,325,000 for the National Space

Grant College and Fellowship program. This amount is an increase

of \$1,225,000 to the fiscal year 2003 pre-rescission appropriation of

\$24,100,000 and an increase of \$6,225,000 to the budget request.

The amount provided will fund the current core programs in 52

Space Grant Consortia, including 35 states at \$475,000 each (including

7 upgrades), 17 states at \$300,000 each and \$3,600,000 for

Workforce Supplement Awards.
